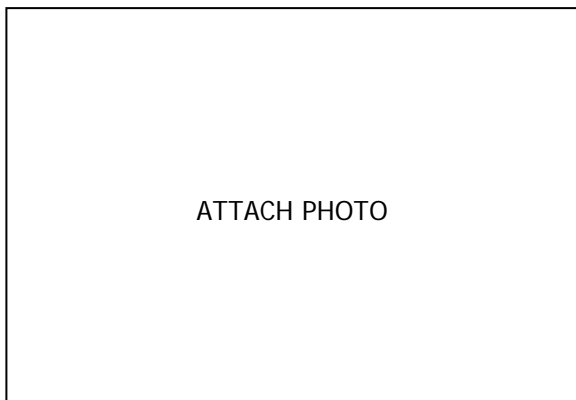

Please read carefully:

- To the best of my knowledge, my child is in good physical and emotional health.
- I, the parent/guardian, of the named child, hereby give approval to his/her participation in this youth activity. I understand that football/cheerleading is a physical sport and that injuries do occur. I assume all the risks and hazards incidental to such participation, including transportation to and from activities; and I do hereby waive, release and agree to hold harmless NBYSA, coaches, organizers, sponsors, supervisors, participants and persons transporting the player to or from activities, from any claim arising out of an injury to the player, whether the result of negligence or any other cause.
- **Refund Policy: Refunds for non-participation will only be made within 10 business days of the date of registration minus administrative fee of \$50.00 per family. After two week from the date of registration refunds will only be given to active participants whom have a valid excuse to be determined by NBYSA senior staff. No refunds will be issued after September 1, 2009 for any reason.**
- Banquet Ticket Fee: At the time when Equipment is distributed to the participants you are also required to purchase one banquet ticket per family. Each participant is required to have one adult accompany them to the banquet. The purchase of the banquet ticket is to show your support and dedication to your child as well as the North Bronx Youth Sports Association. The Banquet is held at the end of the athletic season.
- A returned check fee of \$35 shall be assessed regardless of the reason.

FUNDRAISING AGREEMENT

As with any non-profit organization, the N.B.Y.S.A Football and Cheerleading program depends heavily on fundraisers to help maintain an organized, eventful, successful season. The fundraiser for the 2009 season shall vary for which each participant shall be required to raise \$175.00. I agree to participate in this fundraiser and understand that the amounts for this fundraiser are an integral part and bear the same terms as my registration fee obligation. Amounts of the fundraising are due no later than September 1, 2009. I also understand that if these fees are not paid as outlined herein, I will be responsible for any costs in collections and my child may not be allowed to participate in any N.B.Y.S.A sponsored events until these fees are paid in full. INCLEMENT WEATHER POLICY

Please note that Football is an ALL WEATHER sport. As an organization we do not have the luxury of calling a game because of rain. Based on the rules of the Football Leagues that we are members of, a game can only be called by a Referee on the field. This means that regardless of weather conditions ALL PLAYERS must report to the field on a game day. As a result we must practice in the rain to prepare for playing in the rain. _____ (initial here). **All participants are required to dress accordingly for the weather of the day. NBYSA will not be responsible for youth who do not come to a practice, game or event properly dressed for inclement weather.** We will take precautions for the safety of the participants however all participants should have appropriate apparel to protect them during the inclement weather.

If a game is scheduled and we fail to produce the mandatory minimum of 16 players on our side to play a game due to parents keeping them at home because of rain, the NBYSA organization will be exposed to a **financial penalty of \$300 per game.** Therefore all players must appear at each game before the game can be called. **If NBYSA is exposed to a financial penalty for failing to produce the required number of participants for a game or event NBYSA reserves the right to impose this penalty on participants who were absent on the day in question at \$25 per participant at the discretion of the NBYSA Board.**

All players should always bring a spare T-shirt, sweat shirt, socks and any necessary undergarments for all practices and games just in case these articles become soaked and the temperature drops during a practice, game or event. When practicing in bad weather we will take safety into consideration and modify the practices as needed including bringing the practice into the community center across the street from the practice field. If there is heavy rain before practice begins, the meeting place will be the hallway of the community center, 135 Einstein Loop. The entrance is near the pizza shop.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

PARTICIPANTS (FOOTBALL PLAYERS OR CHEERLEADERS) WHO DO NOT COMPLETE THE SEASON ARE NOT ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE A TROPHY OR COMPLIMENTARY BANQUET TICKET

A COMPLETE SEASON is a season where the participant may only miss one game or event with advance 24 hour notice before the start of the game or event, during the Spring and/or Fall season. The participant must not have any outstanding balances, the participants rental equipment &/or uniform is returned and ALL fundraising commitments are fulfilled. Only then he/she is eligible for a trophy & 1 (one) complimentary banquet ticket. _____ (initial here)

Participants **MUST** eat appropriately 1-2 hours before all practices and games. **WE ARE NOT** responsible for feeding players at practices, games or events. _____ (initial here) Players are **NOT ALLOWED** to eat meals during and in between practice or games.

Lost items will not be replaced by NBYSA. **MAKE SURE YOUR CHILD HAS A DUFFLE BAG.**

Parents are responsible for picking their children up from practice or games in a timely fashion. Participants must be picked up 15 minutes before the practice sessions ends and within 15 minutes before returning home from an away games. Parents will be informed of an approximate time that the team will return from a game. Parents are expected to be there to pick up their child.
